At the courtesy of the listed Chapter House locations and Department of Family Services office locations, the community visits will include an on-site NFAS staff member to accept the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), General Assistance (GA), Burial Assistance (BA), Community Services Block Grant (CSGB), and Navajo School Clothing and School Supplies (NSCSS) applications.

Every financial assistance program the NFAS offers, requires an application with supporting documentation. When applying be prepared to provide vital records for all household members. Depending on the financial assistance that a household or individual is applying for, income statements will be required.

“It is advised to call your nearest NFAS office to inquire about required documentation before visiting a community outreach location,” stated Raeann Metteba, NFAS Manager.
